



2013 International Convention | Lisbon, Portugal

23,000 ATTENDEE CHALLENGE

Thanks to a generous contribution by an anonymous donor, if the final paid Lisbon Convention registration reaches 23,000 attendees, the top 10 districts with the highest per capita registration as defined below for the 2013 Rotary International Convention will be credited with a US\$10,000 Annual Fund-SHARE contribution.

I. Guidelines

- A minimum of 23,000 final paid registrants must be achieved for Rotary International to qualify for this donation. If 23,000 final paid registrations is not reached, this challenge will be null and void.
- Registration percentage will be calculated based on number of net paid registrants as a percentage of the district's total membership per Rotary International's January 2013 membership data. All paid convention registrants are eligible
- Volunteers, vendors, children under the age of 5, exhibitors, sponsors and others who are not registered for the full convention and/or those whose registration fee has been waived are not eligible and will not be included.

II. Timeline

- Applies to eligible registrations received between 5 May 2012 and 26 June 2013.
- Final awards will be made following the convention based on final net registrations materialized (excluding cancellations and/or refunds).
- The top ten qualifying districts will be notified by e-mail no later than 15 July 2013, and announced on rotary.org in August 2013. Each qualifying district will be credited with a US\$10,000 Annual Fund-SHARE contribution for the 2012-13 Rotary year. The contribution will count towards the district's 2012-13 Annual Fund per capita achievement and result in US\$5,000 in District Designated Funds available for district and global grants in 2015-16.

III. Terms and Conditions

- Other than the specific donation in the Rotary district's name to The Rotary Foundation as specified, this incentive has no cash value and no cash award will be provided to the top qualifying districts. No transfer, assignment or substitution of award will be permitted. However, should a district be disqualified for any reason, said district's donation may instead be made in the name of a runner-up district, if any, in Rotary International's sole discretion.
- Rotary International reserves the right to modify the incentive rules as necessary and as permitted by law. Rotary International's decision is final on all matters relating to this incentive. Void where prohibited or restricted by law.
- Rotary International disclaims all responsibility for (1) any incorrect, incomplete, illegible or inaccurate information, whether caused by Convention Registrant, the Rotary District and/or the Rotary District Governor for printing, typographical, technical or other errors or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in this incentive; (2) technical failures of any kind, including, but not limited to, malfunctions, interruptions, or disconnections in phone lines, computer or network hardware or software or Internet transmissions, whether electronic, human or mechanical; (3) unauthorized human intervention in any part of the registration process or the incentive; (4) printing, typographical, technical, computer, network or human error which may occur in the administration of the incentive, the uploading, processing or judging of convention registration materials or the tabulation thereof, the announcement of the top qualifying districts or in any incentive-related materials; (5) late, lost, undeliverable, garbled, damaged, misdirected, misrouted or stolen registration materials; or (6) any injury, loss or damage to persons or property, including, but not limited to, Convention Registrant's, Rotary District's or Rotary District Governor's computer or other equipment, which may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from Convention Registrant's, Rotary District's or Rotary District Governor's participation in the incentive or receipt or use or misuse of any donor funds awarded.
- In the event of a tie or ties between two or more districts, the number of top qualifying districts will be adjusted to include the tying districts and the amount of donation per district will be re-allocated accordingly, so as not to exceed the maximum total US\$100,000 donation from the donor, in Rotary International's sole discretion.
