

Step-by-step Guide to Completing the Club and District Recommendation



Meet with your peace fellowship candidates

Candidates may reach out for guidance and request an application recommendation. Meet with your candidates in person or virtually to share knowledge of Rotary and the fellowship. Assess their readiness for the fellowship and ask for a PDF of their application to review and provide feedback.

Discuss submitting a club/district recommendation

Consult with club or district leaders and district Rotary Peace Fellowship subcommittee members about key points to include in a candidate's recommendation. Decide who will submit the recommendation.



Receive your club/district recommendation request

Candidates will send their Rotary contact an email link to the recommendation form within their online application.

Complete and submit your club/district recommendation

Complete all questions comprehensively. This helps application evaluators know more about a candidate's dedication, abilities, and potential for impact. Click the Submit tab to enter the recommendation. Preview the recommendation form questions:

- How do you know this candidate?
- In what ways does the candidate demonstrate their commitment and leadership in peace and development?
 - How well has the candidate researched the Rotary Peace Fellowship and justified their center preferences?
- Is there anything else about the candidate that would be helpful to those making the final selection?
